

AOCD 2010 Competition Rules and Guidelines

The 4th AOCD (All-Ohio Competition Duettists) will be held June 11-12, 2010 at Bluffton University, Bluffton, Ohio. Robert Vandall states "this is a tremendous growth experience and gives the students the opportunity to realize some of their musical and performance goals"!

Bluffton University is located just off I-75, between Findlay and Lima, Ohio. Lodging is available locally at the Comfort Inn or in the Bluffton University dorm. Additional information will be available in January.

Scheduling will be determined by the number of entries. Students and teachers will receive schedules and accompanying information by the end of March. The competition requirements are (1) **Classical** piece and (1) **Creative** piece. The **Classical** piece can be chosen from the Baroque, Classical and Romantic periods OR a composition written in a classical style by a present day composer. The **Creative** piece is performed in costume and make-up to match the composition.

Students may enter in the following divisions/categories:

- **ELEMENTARY DIVISION: up through grade 6**
 - Category 1: all levels of elementary music
 - Category 2: early intermediate to intermediate music
 - Category 3: all levels of late intermediate to early advanced music

- **JUNIOR DIVISION: 7th, 8th and 9th grade**
 - Category 1: early intermediate to intermediate levels of music
 - Category 2: late intermediate to early advanced levels of music
 - Category 3: advanced levels of music

- **SENIOR DIVISION: 10th, 11th and 12th grade**
 - Category 1: early intermediate to intermediate levels of music
 - Category 2: late intermediate to early advanced levels of music
 - Category 3: advanced music levels of music

The registration fee is \$60.00 per 2P4H and 1P4H teams; \$80.00 per 2P8H teams. A \$9.00 affiliate fee per student will be charged to cover the cost of pins, added bars and membership card.

Each teacher should

1. Complete one copy of the TEACHER INFORMATION FORM.
2. Complete an ENTRY FORM for each group.
Forms should be completed by the teachers, not the students!
