REGULATIONS: READ VERY CAREFULLY

1. FEES:

- \$10.00 fee to be paid by each student.
- **\$14.00 fee to be paid by each student of non-OMTA-member teachers.**
- Teachers submit **one check payable to OMTA** for the total amount due from all students.
- Fess will not be returned for any reason.

2. APPLICATIONS:

- Teachers are responsible for making copies of this form and completing each application. (No reductions or enlargements allowed).
- Fill out legibly. Spell names **CORRECTLY**. These applications will be used by the judges.
- Staple together applications of family members who wish to perform the same hour and circle their last names in red. Students playing a **DUET** should be stapled together,also.
- Applications will not be accepted without payment.
- APPLICATIONS & FEES must be POSTMARKED by January 30, 2009.**
- NO CHANGES will be made once applications have been received. The schedule will not be changed for any reason.

- Teachers: on a separate sheet of paper, please list all of your entering students ALPHABETICALLY and send with applications.**

3. TIME REQUIREMENTS:

- Beginners (Level II to Level III): One piece, three minute limit.
- Intermediate to Advanced: One piece, seven minute limit.
- Students may be stopped if their piece exceeds the time limit.

4. MUSIC:

- A clean, published edition of the music must be presented. **No photocopies** will be accepted.
- No music which is an adaptation, transcription or simplification is permitted in MTNA-OMTA-sponsored events.
- Music must be memorized.
- Measures **MUST** be numbered.

5. STUDENTS:

- Must wear proper public performance attire.
- Arrive on time (arriving late will forfeit your performance time and fee).

6. TEACHERS:

- You must volunteer **TWO** hours of your time the day of the festival. Indicate a.m. or p.m.
- You will receive your assignment and students' schedules by mail (or Feb. TPTA meeting).
